Who can be nominated?

Any local elected official who represents Medina, Portage or Summit County is eligible for nomination including county commissioners, mayors, city council members, state representatives, etc. Those who cannot be nominated include political appointees or officials not elected in a general election. Members of the Greater Akron Chamber or local Chamber Executive may nominate an elected official.
