CHINA XI'AN ITINERARY

Day 1 - October 15, 2009 - JFK/Beijing

Board afternoon flight CA982 by 4:20pm to Beijing. You begin your adventure as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner, crossing the International Dateline.

Day 2 - October 16, 2009 - Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, the capital of China, at 6:00pm. At the airport, you will be met by your local tour guide. Your first evening meal will be a wonderful Peking Roast Duck dinner. Afterwards you will transfer to your hotel.

Day 3 - October 17, 2009 - Beijing

In the morning visit the Temple of Heaven, built in 1420 A.D., where the emperors prayed to the heaven for a good harvest. Sight-seeing also includes a tour bus excursion to the Great Wall, the 4,000-mile long and 2,000 years old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by naked eye from the moon. In route visit the Jade Factory. During day 3, you will visit to the Ming Tombs, one of 13 Ming Emperors' Tombs, which is fully excavated and open for exploration. Also during the day, you will be able to enjoy the Chinese Acrobatic Show.

Day 4 - October 18, 2009 - Beijing

Visit the Tian An Men Square, the largest square in the world. From there, you will visit The Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, home of 24 emperors with a total space of 9,999 rooms. Sight-seeing includes a trip to the Pearl Market. Visit the amazing Summer Palace, known for many significant features such as the Long Corridor with painted gallery, Kunming Lake and Longevity Hill, Seventeen-Arch Bridge and Marble Boat. **Optional Tour: Hutong Tour in Beijing (\$35 per person USD)**

Day 6 - October 20, 2009 - Xi'an

Sight-seeing continues with a morning visit to the Terra-Cotta Warriors at the Tomb of the First Emperor of Qin Dynasty. In route visit the Xian Art Ceramic Factory. On your way back, you will stop and visit the Ancient City Wall and Banpo Museum, a preserved pre-historical cavemen site.

Visit the Bund, a famous waterfront park and afterwards the Shanghai Silk Rug Factory. In the afternoon you will visit the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over arching trees.
